



How to Dispose of Recyclable Materials at Hirokawa Town's Garbage Stations

Wednesday

> PET Bottles



- Wash out with water.
- Remove all the labels and caps, and put them in the burnable garbage.



- If the items cannot be cleaned properly, put them in the burnable garbage.

> Cans



- Wash out with water.
- Do not crush the cans.
- You can also dispose of food cans.

- If the items cannot be cleaned properly, put them in the non-burnable garbage.



> Glass bottles



- Wash out with water.
- Remove the caps.
- Separate the bottles by color into three categories: clear, brown, and other.



! Please remove any broken bottles, cups, cosmetic bottles, oil bottles, and so on. They are recycled as 'glass'.

Distinguish the color of the bottle by its mouth.

> Glass



- We accept cracked glass.
- Wash out oil bottles with water.
- Separate glass bottles used for food from those used for drinks.

> Newspapers, Papers, Magazines, and Books



- Bundle them together neatly with string.

> Metals

- We do not accept anything that sticks out of a garbage bag.
- Spray cans should be punctured before disposal.

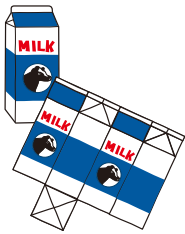


Rice bowls (ceramic)

> Cartons



- Wash out with water and dry.
- Cut and open, then bundle together with string.

> Batteries



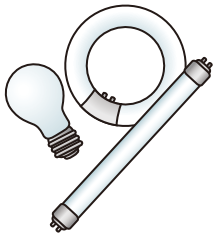
- We accept dry cell batteries and button cell batteries.

> Cardboard



- Align cardboard according to size.
- Bundle together with string.

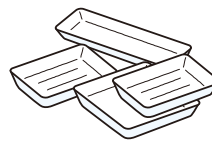
> Fluorescent Lamps



- We accept straight tubes, circular tubes, and regular bulbs.
- Dispose of any LED bulbs as non-burnable garbage.



> Trays

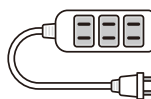


- Wash out with water.
- We only accept white trays.
- We do not accept natto trays and cup noodle pots.
- Put them in the designated transparent bag.



> Small Home Appliances

- We do not accept anything that sticks out of a garbage bag.
- We do not accept ITVs, air conditioners, refrigerators, and washing machines, and so on. Please ask an electronics store to pick them up.

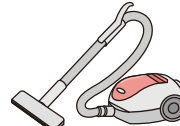

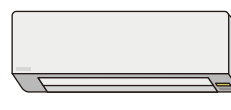
